Arrival in Merida. Reception at the Airport. Transfer to your Hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 02: MERIDA (Tour Uxmal and Kabah) | INC: B/L

After breakfast, full day tour to visit Uxmal and Kabah archeological areas. First we will visit Uxmal ruins, one of the most popular ancient Mayan cities. "Uxmal" in Maya means "three times built". Here the guide will explain in depth the Puuc architectural style of buildings such as the Nun's Quadrangle, the Ball court, the Turtle House and the Governor Palace. This Puuc style stands as a highly decorative and detailed one. It owes its name to the Puuc hills located in the region. The Governor Palace is the most famous structure in Uxmal because it is the best example of the Puuc Style. It had been renowned as the most beautiful building in Mesoamerica.

After our Uxmal tour you will explore the archeological site of Kabah, Mayan name which means "lord of a strong hand". Kabah is linked to Uxmal by a "sacbeh" or white road used for ceremonial purposes. Kabah is one of the stops of the Puuc Route and here you can find many structures with carved masks of the God Chaac, the important god of rain for the Mayans. Due to the absence of cenotes in this region Mayans had to build their own cisterns and prayed for rain to his God.

Your last stop before you return to Merida will be a restaurant for a delicious regional meal.

DAY 03: MERIDA / (Tour to Chichen Itza archeological park) / CANCUN | INC: B/L

Breakfast. Today we will pick you up early in the morning and drive 1.5 hrs southeast of the city of Merida to the ruins of the ancient Mayan city of Chichen Itza. The name of Chichen Itza comes from the Mayan words: Chi (Mouth), Chen (hole or well) and Itza (Itza people). All together, these Mayan words mean "At the mouth of the Well of the Itza people". DAY 01: CANCUN | INC: ALL INCLUSIVE PLAN

Arrival in Cancun. Reception at the Airport. Transfer to your Hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 02: CANCUN | INC: ALL INCLUSIVE PLAN

DAY 03: CANCUN / CHICHEN ITZA | INC: B

After breakfast transfer to the Hotel Chichen Itza, located in the very heart of the archaeological park with its own entrance to the temples.

DAY 04: CANCUN / CHICHEN ITZA (Tour Chichen Itza archaeological park) | INC: B/L/D

Begin your day with breakfast at your hotel. Then, a private guided tour of the site begins at the Great Plaza, the heart of Chichen Itza. Visiting the Ball Game Court, the Temple of the Jaguars, the famous Temple (pyramid) of God KuKulkan, the Tzompantli Platform, the Temple of the Warriors or Temple of The One Thousand Columns. Then you will visit the Sacred Cenote, the Mayan Observatory and the set of buildings constructed during the Classic Maya Period, The Nunnery, La Iglesia and Akab Dzib.

Lunch will be served at Mayaland Hotel. Enjoy the afternoon relaxing by the pool or taking an additional horseback riding tour. You can also stroll through our beautiful gardens and watch the birds. The Yucatan boasts more species than the United States and Canada combined.

If you are staying at the Hotel Chichen Itza® you will be driven back to your hotel.

In the evening we will attend the light and sound show staged nightly at the archaeological park. A play of light on the ancient buildings and tales of warlike rulers, priests and Mayan Gods weave their spell. You will leave Chichen Itza enchanted.

Dinner will be served at the Mayaland Hotel El Mural dining room and terrace.

DAY 05: CHICHEN ITZA (Tour to Ek Balam-Rio Lagartos pink flamingo reserve) | INC: B/L

After breakfast, we will depart to the northern coast of the Yucatan Peninsula via the magnificent site of Ek Balam to Rio Lagartos on the Mexican Gulf coast. Ek Balam is one of the most mysterious cities ever discovered. Its main temple features a Jaw of jaguar with delicate stucco relieve and feathered sculptures. At arriving to Rio Lagartos, we will take a wonderful boat ride through the mangroves to visit the feeding ground of the beautiful pink flamingoes. A box lunch will be provided.

Return to the hotel for a late afternoon at leisure.

Overnight at the Hotel.

DAY 06: CHICHEN ITZA / (City tour Izamal and Merida) / UXMAL | INC: B/L/D

After breakfast, we will depart to Merida calling at the colonial city of Izamal on the way, where we will visit the Convent of San Francisco de Padua, the central park, the regional market and the pyramid of Kinich Kakmo located downtown.

Upon arrival in Merida, we will take a walking tour of the city center visiting the Zocalo or Main Square, site of the stately Cathedral; the Casa de Montejo, a 16th century home of Don Francisco de Montejo, the founder of the city; the City Hall and palace of the State Government. We will take a walking tour of the city market for authentic arts and crafts.

Lunch is served at a typical Mexican restaurant where you will taste a sample of authentic local cuisine and listen to the serenades of strolling trovadores. We continue our walking tour to the church of Tercera Orden, a beautiful 17th century monastery; the Peon Contreras Theater and the University of Yucatan. We will then board a traditional horse-drawn carriage or Calesa for a ride to Paseo de Montejo and a visit to the Regional Museum of Anthropology and History.

At the end of this visit, a deluxe vehicle tour around the Monument to the Nation and past the 19th century mansions on Paseo de Montejo and Avenida Colon concludes our city tour. We continue to Uxmal.



Dinner at the Hacienda Uxmal Hotel or The Lodge at Uxmal.
Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 07: UXMAL (Tour Uxmal Archaeological Park) | INC: B/D

Breakfast at The Lodge at Uxmal or Hacienda Uxmal Hotel. We will walk to the temples at Uxmal for a guided tour that includes the oval-shaped Magician's Pyramid; the Nun's Quadrangle with its magnificent friezes depicting the Mayan Rain God; the magnificent Palace of the Governor and the impressive Great Pyramid.

Free afternoon for relaxing at the hotel where you can swim in our beautiful sparkling swimming pools or enjoy our spa.

In the evening you are invited to attend the Uxmal light and sound show, staged nightly in the Nun's Quadrangle, Uxmal's central plaza. The music, dialogue and illumination take place in a magnificent setting and the event is an unforgettable introduction to the history and legends of the ancient city and the magnificent Puuc Mayan culture. When inaugurated in 1975, this sound and light spectacle was acclaimed to be the finest in the world.

Dinner and overnight at The Lodge at Uxmal or Hacienda Uxmal Hotel.

DAY 08: UXMAL (Tour to Town of Becal and city of Campeche) | INC: B/L/D

Breakfast will be served at the hotel. We will take you to the village of Becal, famous for the Panama hats made by artisans who work in caves to preserve the quality of the palm fronds. Afterwards we shall proceed to the city of Campeche once a fortified Pirate haven. Here one of the United Nations World Heritage Sites, as are Chichen Itza and Uxmal.

Enjoy a delicious seafood lunch at a local restaurant. We will do a walking city tour and visit a number of small museums and places of interest in this,

Dinner and overnight at Hacienda Uxmal Hotel or The Lodge at Uxmal.

DAY 09: UXMAL (Tour to Kabah – Sayil- Ticul – Labna – Loltun) | INC: B/L/D

Depart from Uxmal after breakfast. First stop is Kabah where you will see the Codz Pop, a palace famous for its facade of 250 Chaac masks and statues of ancient rulers of the site; the Palace and the Arch of Kabah which

marks the entrance to the Sacbe or linking path between Kabah and Uxmal.

We will then visit Sayil, a very unique site in the land of the Maya for its gracious three-tiered palace: a labyrinth of 70 rooms adorned with columns and beautifully Chaac masks carved in stone.

Labna is a lovely classical Puuc Maya village that among its temples of note we find The Palace and The Mirador.

Minutes away are the town of Ticul, where the living Maya will show us the makings of their pottery and reproductions of ancient Mayan figurines.

A box lunch will be provided along the way to the caves of Loltun, natural masterpieces with pre-Maya engravings dating back over four thousand years as well as interesting geological formations and markings of The Yucatan Peninsula's resurgence from the sea in the Quaternary Era.

Next to Loltun is the city of Tekax. We will visit a 17th century convent and fortress like chapel that is a silent

testimony to Yucatan's turbulent past: Maya revolts against Spanish rule that resulted in the war of castes.

Dinner and overnight at the Hacienda Uxmal or The Lodge at Uxmal.

DAY 10: UXMAL (Tour to Tulum) / CANCUN - END OF THE TOUR | INC: B

After breakfast we will depart to the archaeological site of Tulum located in the Caribbean Coast. After a brief visit, your deluxe van will take you to the hotel of your choice in Cancun or to the airport.

Mexico City – Oaxaca – San Cristobal de las Casas – Palenque – Campeche – Merida - Cancun

Itinerary:

DAY 01: MEXICO CITY | INC: -

Arrival in Mexico City. Reception at the Airport. Transfer to your Hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 02: MEXICO CITY (City Tour with Anthropology Museum) | INC: B

Breakfast. You will be transferred in a scenic passing, through the front of some facades of beautiful historical downtown buildings, such as the Palace of Fine Arts, the House of tile, arriving to the heart of Mexico, with his majestic Arms Square ""El Zócalo".

You will be entered the National Palace to admire the macro mural of Diego Rivera in the main staircase a veritable compendium of the history of Mexico, from the particular point of view of the great Mexican painter. We will be acceded by the Metropolitan Cathedral the largest in Latin America, home to the Archdiocese of Mexico, crossing its Ships and Altars.

We are leaving to continue to make a panoramic tour of other beautiful facades of buildings architectural expression. Arriving to a craft gallery where you can buy a souvenir.

You will be transited by the most cosmopolitan boulevard, Reforma Boulevard, which was designed by the Emperor Maximilian, inspired in the Parisian model of the Champs Elysees, which allows for important buildings and monuments. We arrived to the Chapultepec area forest, to access to the world-renowned National Anthropology Museum, where they will complete a comprehensive view of the ancient Aztec city of Tenochtitlan and its glory with the visit and the Aztec room. Afterwards we will return to your hotel around 14 30 hrs.

DAY 03: MEXICO CITY (Tour to Guadalupe Shrine & Teotihuacan Pyramids) | INC: B

After breakfast, departure to visit two impressive ceremonial centers, Teotihuacan (Prehispanic) and the Shrine of Guadalupe (contemporary), which outline the majority religious development of the Mexican people. We will begin visiting the pre-Hispanic archaeological site of Tlatelolco, or also known as the "Plaza de las Tres Culturas" with its colonial church of Santiago.

We will continue to Teotihuacan "the city of the Gods", according with the Aztec myth, with more than 2,500 years of History. This place had a vital development, based on the Uses of the natural fiber textiles and obsidian tools and raw materials exchange. This will be explained in detail in a crafts center and you will have the chance to buy a souvenir alluding to this visit.

You will be enter to the enigmatic archaeological site, visiting the temples of "Quetzalpapalotl" (bird - butterfly) and the "Feathered Shells" and the whole Pyramid of the Moon. Finally ending with the impressive Pyramid of the Sun. You will be guided into a local restaurant for your take your lunch (not included).

Afterwards you will be delight to visit of the Shrine of Guadalupe, which is Mexico's largest religious shrine, where the San Juan Diego's Tilma is kept, with the most venerated image in Mexico, the Virgin of Guadalupe, "Matron Saint of America".

DAY 04: MEXICO CITY / (Tour to Puebla) / OAXACA | INC: B

Breakfast. Depart by land to visit first Santa Maria Tonantzintla, masterpiece of the Native baroque hand made church, the splendid Rosario chapel in Puebla, the Cathedral, the Main Plaza and the art and crafts market. Continue to Oaxaca. Arrival and accommodation.

DAY 05: OAXACA (Tour to Mitla, Tule & Montealban) | INC: B

Breakfast. In the morning visit to Monte Alban, archeological area built in top of a mountain. There are Olmec, Zapotec and Mixtec culture vestiges, Grand Plaza, the Observatory, the Steele of Dancers and the tomb number 7 (the latest discoveries).

In the afternoon visit to Mitla, the city of the death. This is a beautiful place all made in grecas with a special symbolism to the death. See the largest Tule tree in America and visit the unique Oaxaca city, museum and Santo Domingo church and the Golden museum. Return to Oaxaca.

DAY 06: OAXACA / SAN CRISTOBAL DE LAS CASAS | INC: B/L

Breakfast box and early departure to the sierra. By the mountain enjoy the landscape to arrive in Chiapa de Corzo and take a ride by the river into the Sumidero Canyon. Lunch included. Visit the fountain mudejar style and arrive in San Cristobal de las Casas. Accommodation.

DAY 07: SAN CRISTOBAL DE LAS CASAS (Visit the Ancient Villages) | INC: B

Breakfast. Leave to visit the ancient villages of San Juan Chamula and Zinacantan. These small communities are very traditional and many of the villagers continue to follow ancient religious practices within the Catholic churches. In the main church of Chamula, where a traditional Christian mass hasn't been held for 40 years, people sit on the pine needle covered floor and receive treatments from local shamans amid clouds of burning incense. Afternoon at leisure to walk by the cobblestone streets, see on your own the church of San Domingo and the Market place.

DAY 08: SAN CRISTOBAL DE LAS CASAS / (Visit Agua Azul and Misolha Waterfalls) / PALENQUE | INC: B/D

After breakfast at your hotel transfer to Palenque, the Agua Azul and Misolha Waterfalls en route. Agua Azul is one of those places where the magic is real, and the real is magical. It is as if the aquamarine waters of the Caribbean had tunneled beneath the ground to burst forth in cascades amongst the rainforest. After descending from Tonina we will break our journey here and have time to explore and swim among this spectacular series of waterfalls. Refreshed and dried off, we will continue on to the secluded waterfall of Misol-Ha that cascades into a pool surrounded by tropical forest. Contact with nature is essential to an understanding of the Mayan world, for it was knowledge of the natural rhythms of life in the tropics, knowledge accumulated through centuries of village life, that underpinned the awesome power of the kings and spawned perhaps the greatest civilization of ancient America. Continue to Palenque for accommodation.

DAY 09: (Tour to Palenque) / CAMPECHE | INC: B/D

DAY 04: CUSCO / SACRED VALLEY(Full day tour to Sacred Valley and Pisac) | INC: B/L

The Sacred Inca Valley welcomes us this day. We will stop at Awanacancha, a complex where we will be able to feed Andean camelid: the llamas and alpacas, and also a great opportunity to chat with the local people who will show us their weaving and dyeing of their traditional textiles. We will then go to the Colonial and Inca Pisac. Discover one of the most beautiful Inca archaeological sites of the Sacred Valley, strategically located on top of the mountain that dominates the Colonial town of Pisac. Free time to buy handicrafts and explore the town. Buffet lunch. Visit to the store of artist and sculptor Pablo Seminario.

DAY 05: SACRED VALLEY / MACHU PICCHU (Tour to Machu Picchu) | INC: B/L

Our adventure journey takes us now to less explored treasures of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. First stop: Moray, a place with breathtaking views thanks to its colossal concentric terraces resembling a coliseum. What did they use it for? The terraces recreated 20 different types of microclimates, and they were studied to ensure the agricultural production of the empire. DAY 09: QUITO / GALAPAGOS ISLANDS (Santa Cruz) | INC: B/D

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Baltra (2 hours flight). Passengers are picked up at the airport by our naturalist guides and taken on a ten minute bus drive to the pier to board the M/V Galapagos Legend.

Afternoon: Dry landing. A 45-minute bus ride will take us to the Santa Cruz highlands, located to the northwest of Puerto Ayora, where we will find a natural reserve with giant tortoises. These enormous and slow-moving reptiles are responsible for the island's name and therefore approaching them in their humid and forested abode is always an inspiring adventure. They can weigh between 250 and 300 kg and can live up to 150-200 years. Additionally, travelers can walk inside surprising lava tubes; we also visit Pit Craters created from the collapse of surface materials into chamber fissures underground. It's a great place spot to spot Vermilion Flycatcher as we walk inside an endemic *Scalesia* forest.

DAY 10: EGAS PORT / SALT MINES (Santiago) / BARTOLOME ISLAND | INC: B/L/D

Wet landing on a beach of black volcanic sand, visited by Darwin in 1835. The first section of the trail is comprised of volcanic ash (eroded tuff) and the other half of partially uneven terrain is comprised of volcanic basaltic rock lounging the shoreline.

The unique, truly striking layered terrain of Santiago's shores is home to a variety of resident and migrant birds, including the bizarre Yellow-crowned Night Heron and astounding array of marine wildlife including lobster, starfish and marine iguanas grazing on algae beds alongside Sally Light-foot Crabs.

Colonies of endemic fur seals swimming in cool water pools formed by volcanic rocks are also a highlight.

Snorkeling here offers rarities such as octopus and squid. We organize optional visits to the Salt Mines where you can observe the two species of sea lions: fur and Galapagos sea lions.

Afternoon: Dry landing in Bartolome Island. We discover a fascinating moonscape formed by different volcanic parasitic cones —lava bombs, spatter, cinder cones —as we hike to the summit for impressive views of the surrounding islands, including the eroded tuff cone Pinnacle Rock. We also encounter marine iguanas and lava lizards.

Beach time is a great opportunity to snorkel and see (perhaps swim with) Galapagos Penguins, sea turtles and White-tipped Reef Sharks among a great variety of colorful fish. For many visitors, this may turn out to be the best of snorkeling experiences; the water here is generally clear, without too much surf and full of marine life. Due to its geographical location, the lack of vegetation is immediately noticeable. Pioneer plants are observed, so called because they are the first to establish roots on new ground. They include *Tiquilia nesiotica* (which is endemic to the island) and *Chamaesyce* (known as



sand mat or spurge in English), lava cactus, and *Scalesia* bushes. Behind the beach we have dunes covered by mangroves.

DAY 11: DRAGON HILL (Santa Cruz) / NORTH SEYMOUR | INC: B/L/D

Dry landing. We walk by a brackish lagoon where feeding flamingos can be occasionally found. The trail leads across typical dry zone vegetation up to Dragon Hill, an important nesting ground for endemic land iguanas, offering lovely views of the anchorage and neighboring islands. The forest is home to mockingbirds, Darwin’s finches, Yellow Warblers and Galapagos Doves.

Afternoon: Dry landing. This is perhaps one of the busiest tourist destinations on the archipelago. Off of Baltra Island (where the airport is located) and not far from Santa Cruz, North Seymour is the most accessible for day trips out of Santa Cruz’s main port, Puerto Ayora. An approximately two hour walk amidst large nesting colonies of blue-footed boobies, magnificent and great frigatebirds, and swallow-tailed gulls for an in depth encounter with sea bird breeding cycles and as well as sea lions. You will also encounter sea lions, land iguanas, and on a lucky day, you might even come across a Galapagos Snake.

DAY 01: LIMA | INC: D

DAY 02: BUENOS AIRES (City Tour - Tango Show with dinner) | INC: B/D

DAY 03: BUENOS AIRES (Tigre & Delta Tour) | INC: B

Breakfast. Pick up from your Hotel Lobby to leave Buenos Aires City heading for the town of Tigre, one hour away, where we will board a tourist boat to navigate along Delta and its islands. The life of the "isleños" (people who live on the islands of the Delta) is very special. We will learn about their customs, culture and ways of life. On the way back to Buenos Aires city we will drive by the elegant residences of the well-off, located in the northern suburbs, and the San Isidoro neighborhood. DAY 05: SALTA (Tour to Humahuaca Gorge) | INC: B

Early in the morning after breakfast we will go to visit the Quebrada de Humahuaca which is situated in the west of Jujuy Province, 126 km away from Horacio Guzmán International Airport, which is located in San Salvador de Jujuy City, capital city of the Province; and at 2,939 meters above the sea level, on the right verge of N° 9 National Road. Due to the uneven topography of this land, the region presents rather different climates: high temperatures (38°C) are registered during the day, while considerable lower temperatures are registered at night (-10°), and this changes according to the season. This is a colonial city: it worth walking narrow paved streets with streetlamps and adobe houses made Humahuaca one of the most important trade centers of Alto Perú until the end of the XIX Century. Worldwide known due to the imposing Quebrada de Humahuaca, professed as Humanity Heritage by UNESCO, shows a heavenly landscape where Río Grande flows and where great archaeological beds are found in colorful hills. In this region, tourists get in touch with Hispano-America roots in a landscape made of valleys and narrow paths where Indigenous and Spanish cultures merged.

DAY 06: SALTA (Tour Safari to the Clouds) | INC: B

After breakfast, prepare to know the most amazing train , it will take you on an adventure with the ultimate stop being the clouds. You will go up 4200 meters which will entail a journey of 434kms to get

there and back again. It is one of the three tallest trains in the world that goes in and out and traverses through the mountains of the Andes in between spectacular views all the way. You go through part of the city of Salta and traverse in the valley of Lerma so that you can go and see the spectacular colours and then arrive at la Puna. Called Train to the Nubes because of its high altitude, a lot of the time you can see clouds below the train tracks. The amount of curlers, viaducts, tunnels and other windings that appear are all part of the work of the amazing Engineer, Richard Maury who built the train and train tracks bearing in mind the laws of physics, creating a mechanical system that is commonly used for railway formations with reliability that helps them climb such heights. It does not use gears, even for the steepest parts of the climb, because the tracks are arranged in a peculiar way running through a system of zigzags and spirals.

DAY 07: SALTA / SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA | INC: B

Early morning transfer to the Bus Station for your trip to Atacama (12 hs). This is a spectacular journey across the Andes into Chile. Arrival and transfer to your hotel

DAY 08: SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA (Archeological tour – Moon Valley) | INC: B

Breakfast. Early in the morning archeological tour around San Pedro de Atacama: includes visit to Gustave Le Paige Archeological Museum and its interesting collection concerning the evolution of atacamenian culture: the Square, Church and colonial house. Excursion to Pukará de Quitur XII Century Atacamenian fortress, last bastion against the army of the Conquistadors.

Then proceed toward the Valley of the Moon an extraordinary landscape similar to that on the moon. The best place to enjoy the much anticipated Chilean sunset is in the Salt Mountain range, the location of the Mars and Moon valleys. The valleys contain a variety stone, sand-like formations - a result of water and wind. As the sun sinks below the horizon, experience the wonder of the area and its close resemblance to the lunar.

In the evening, one of the most expected moments is the sunset and the best place to appreciate it is the Mountain range of the Salt, with its Mars and Moon Valleys that are saline and sacrilegious conformations product of the mineralogical folding that have taken place for one hundred million years and that originated small mountains of capricious and sculptural forms that at sunset resemble a Lunar landscape. Return to the hotel. Overnight.

DAY 09: SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA (Tour to Geysers de Tatio) | INC: B

Today, discover one of the highest-elevation geyser fields in the world! Watch all around you as over 100 geysers huff and puff, spewing explosive streams of water and gas into the frigid air. The El Tatio Geyser Field stands just over 14,000 feet above sea level in the Andes Mountains of northern Chile and getting there is half the fun. You'll travel up windy scenic mountain roads surrounded by snow covered active and dormant volcanic peaks along the way. Magma beneath the surface acts to heat an underground source of water resulting in an explosive release of pressure.

As you walk through the fields, steam rising all around, the ethereal environment will have you feeling like you're on another planet. The local animal life of the geyser field are awe-inspiring as well, demonstrating that beauty can thrive even in such harsh conditions. Geyser field run off empties into emerald green, geothermal ponds and small streams that trickle down toward lower altitudes. A trip to the third largest geyser field in the world is an experience you won't soon forget!. Overnight.

DAY 10: SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA (Tour to Chuquicamata / SANTIAGO DE CHILE | INC: B

Breakfast. In the morning visit the Chuquicamata mine, the largest open cast copper mine in the world, visit the town workings and industrial plants. Return and transfer to the airport for your flight to Santiago de Chile. Arrival in Santiago and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 11: SANTIAGO DE CHILE (City Tour) | INC: B

Breakfast. Discover the classic attractions of Santiago, the Chilean capital on a 3-hour guided tour. DAY 02: BUENOS AIRES (City Tour – Tango Show with dinner) | INC: B/D

You'll enjoy an optional and free tango lesson, a great 03 course dinner with beverages. Then Transfer to the Hotel.

DAY 03: BUENOS AIRES (Full day tour to Fiesta Gaucha) | INC: B/L

After breakfast join the gaucho fiesta at the Estancia Santa Susana, a typical gaucho ranch located in the district of Campana, just an hour from Buenos Aires. The Estancia's 1200 Hectares (2965 acres) are dedicated to agricultural activities and have been a popular tourist destination for the last 20 years.

During your camp day at Santa Susana ranch you will be able to enjoy a tour with the magnificent landscape of the Argentinean Pampas, just beyond Buenos Aires. Experience the real gaucho lifestyle, Argentinian folklore and understand how the cowboys of Argentina, who made up the majority of the rural population, made a living from hunting and herding cows.

During this full day tour you will have the most authentic experience by horse riding into the enchantment of the endless landscape of the remote Pampas. Be amazed by the true tradition of the cowboys and their typical gaucho skills, enjoy a folkloric performance of typical gaucho dances, Tango and other traditional rhythms, and delight in a full gaucho barbecue that includes the best Argentine beef, salads, drinks and as much quality Argentinean wine as you can take!

Late afternoon return to your hotel.

DAY 04: BUENOS AIRES / USHUAIA | INC: B

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Ushuaia. Reception at the airport. Transfer to your Hotel.

DAY 05: USHUAIA (Tour Tierra del Fuego National Park including Train of the End of the World) | INC: B

After breakfast, early in the morning, pick up from your hotel lobby.

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport for your flight to El Calafate. Arrival and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 07: CALAFATE (Tour Perito Moreno Glacier) | INC: B

DAY 08: CALAFATE / PUERTO NATALES | INC: B

Early breakfast and transfer to Puerto Natales (Chile), one of the most beautiful and breathtaking locations in the world.

DAY 09: PUERTO NATALES (Balmaceda and Serrano Glaciers) | INC: B/L

After breakfast weigh anchor to visit The Serrano and Balmaceda glaciers from the wharf in Puerto Natales, sailing next to the coast to go into in the sine surrounded by hills and forests, where if the conditions of the climate allows it, the sea elephants can be seen resting on the rocks and hundreds of cormorants ventilating their extended wings.

After 3 hours of navigation you arrive at Balmaceda hill (2,035 ms), with its summit covered with ice that falls in colossal snowdrifts to the sea.

The boat comes near the Balmaceda snowdrift and stops in the Serrano snowdrift, where you land for a walk in the forest until the border of the lagoon full of icebergs and with a wonderful view of the hills and the Ultima Esperanza sine. The return to the wharf is made bordering the opposite shore of the sine. (Arrival to the wharf at about 16:30 hrs.)

Daily Navigation during the months of September to March.

From April to September only on Sunday and depending on the climatic conditions.

DAY 10: PUERTO NATALES (Tour Payne Tower and Milodon Cave) | INC: B/L

After breakfast depart Puerto Natales to travel into Torres del Paine National Park, a mountain wonderland of gorgeous valleys, glaciers, lakes and rivers. As the Park central piece Los Cuernos del Paine arises, extremely popular among hikers, trails lead throughout Torres del Paine's awe inspiring scenery. We will start visiting Milodon Cave, a natural monument notable for the 1896 discovery of a giant ground sloth inside called Mylodon darwini. A life size replica of the prehistoric creature, resembling a large bear, stands at the entrance. We will stop at Hosteria Grey Lake where we will enjoy lunch and visit the enormous Grey Glacier that feeds the lake. We will head back toward Puerto Natales through Amarga Lagoon along a route with great views of the Paine Towers (weather dependent). It's the perfect end to a pleasant day journeying through this enchanting Chilean icon.

DAY 11: PUERTO NATALES / PUNTA ARENAS / SANTIAGO DE CHILE | INC: B

Breakfast. Transfer to Punta Arenas for your flight to Santiago de Chile. Arrival and transfer to your hotel, rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 12: SANTIAGO DE CHILE (City Tour) | INC: B

Breakfast. Discover the classic attractions of Santiago, the Chilean capital on a 3-hour guided tour. Situated in the country's central valley, and home to 7 million people, Santiago's rapid economic growth has made it one of South America's most developed cities. Its unique urban environment



artfully unites classic and modern.

Itinerary:

DAY 01: SAO PAULO (City tour) | INC: -/-/-

Arrive to Sao Paulo. Transfer to your hotel.

In the afternoon we will have a City tour. Beginning with a tour through downtown (the oldest area where the city was founded), the residential area of Higienopolis, followed by another residential area, Pacaembu and its football stadium. Then the faculty of medicine (biggest in Latin America), the Butantan Institute with its snake farm and where a visit will be made, the Palace of Bandeirantes (headquarter for the state government), the Morumbi football stadium (biggest private owned stadium - 80.000 people), the elegant residential area of Jardins, the Ibirapuera Park (project of Oscar Niemeyer), Avenida Paulista (the financial center) and return to the hotel.

DAY 02: SAO PAULO / MANAOS (Amazon Jungle) | INC: B/D

Dinner at the lodge included.

Later night tour "Alligator Spotting".

Depart lodge in paddle or motorized canoes, to appreciate the sounds of the jungle at night, with the possibility to spot small alligators (or other nightly creatures). Alligators are spotted because their eyes shine like small red lights, once the alligator is spotted by the guide spotlight, the guide will try to catch a small alligator with his own hands and bring it on to the canoe, and a brief explanation of their habitat follows. The alligator will then be safely release back to the river. (No harm is done to any of the animals). Duration: about 1 hour, a bilingual guide accompanies every group.

DAY 03: AMAZON JUNGLE | INC: B/L/D

Breakfast. During the morning a trip will also be made to the unforgettable MEETING OF THE WATER, where the fast moving black waters of the Rio Negro meet the slower brown waters of the Rio Solimões meet to form the Amazon proper. These two waters run together for miles without mixing as differences in speed, temperature and composition keep them separate. It is an amazing spectacle to behold. "

Itinerary:

DAY 01: RIO DE JANEIRO | INC: -/-/-

Arrival in Rio de Janeiro. Reception at the Airport. Transfer to your Hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 02: RIO DE JANEIRO (Tour to Sugar Loaf and Corcovado Mtn.) | INC: B/L

Breakfast. In the morning, after pick up, you will do a day-long tour. Sugar Loaf and Corcovado Mountains, including the impressive Christ Redeemer statue overlooking the city should definitely be at the top of your list, and Gray Line Rio de Janeiro is the perfect guide for your day. DAY 03: RIO DE JANEIRO (Guanabara Bay Tour - Samba show with dinner) | INC: B/D

Breakfast. This morning we will have a tour to Guanabara Bay.

On January 1st 1502, a Portuguese squad, commanded by Andre Gonçaves, discovered the Guanabara Bay and, judging to be a great river, and being January he gave it the name of Rio de Janeiro. It is the largest bay of the world in volume of water; it has several islands, as the Governor's island, Fundão and Snakes Island.

In the west margin we see Rio de Janeiro, and East the municipal district of Niteroi. Neighborhoods of Botafogo, Flamengo, Urca, Sugar Loaf, Fort São Joao, Flagstone Island, Santa Cruz Fortress, Rio-Niteroi Bridge and all other surrounding beauty are seen from a different perspective as we as we leave "Marina da Gloria " by Saveiro (schooner).

After the tour return to your hotel and free time.

Pick up from your hotel at evening: "Rio nights are electric. Feel the energy in the air... your heart beats faster...music and fun are key ingredients of Rio's exciting nightlife!" This atmosphere is brought to life at Plataforma's nightly Carnival Parade!

Indulge in a traditional Brazillian Barbecue dinner featuring marinated grilled meats and local delicacies. Following dinner, enjoy prime seating for the Plataforma 1 Samba Show... an experience of live music, brilliant costumes, rhythmic drumming and unbelievable dancing!

DAY 04: RIO DE JANEIRO / MANAOS / AMAZON JUNGLE | INC: B/-/D

Breakfast and transfer to the airport for your flight to Manaus. (Arrival must to be before 14:00hs). Arrival in Manaus and transfer to the Tropical'spier, from here the trip via speed boat to the Amazon Eco-Park Lodge. After checked in to their rooms and then will visit the Monkey Forest. The facilities for rehabilitation and re-introduction of wild animals in their habitat (known as Monkey Forest), was created in 1991 with the intention of receiving animals that have been confiscated from illegal commerce. This is a joint project with the Municipal Secretary of Environment and Sustainability. In this center, the animals are initially put into quarantine to be evaluated and taken care of by a team of veterinaries and biologists. The duration of the tour of the center will be about 40 minutes to 1 hour. Following will be lunch, and then a visit to a native resident's house. Guests will depart from the lodge on a boat or motorized canoe, accompanied by a bilingual guide to learn about the traditions and customs of local Amazonian natives. The duration of this tour varies according to the place visited, and during low water level seasons a boat may not be required. At high water level seasons, distant

communities may be visited and the tour can last up to three hours. After visiting the native's house some fishing may be done. Next the guests will have dinner, and then go to a Night tour in canoe. Depart lodge in paddle or motorized canoes, to appreciate the sounds of the jungle at night, with the possibility to spot small alligators (or other nightly creatures). Alligators are spotted because their eyes shine like small red lights. Once the alligator is spotted by the guide's spotlight, he will try to catch a small alligator with his own hands and bring it on to the canoe, and a brief explanation of their habitat follows. The alligator will then be safely released back to the river. (No harm is done to any of the animals) Duration: about 1 hour.

Note: during "high water level" season (from April to August) and on full moon evenings, it might be difficult to find alligators.

DAY 05: AMAZON JUNGLE | INC: B/L/D

After breakfast, guests will go on a nature hike. Biodiversity is the main characteristics of ECOPARK. It includes uncatalogued species in virgin rainforest, natural savannahs and creeks. Several streams of crystal clear warm water run through the rainforest. During the tour, the guide will lead clients and educate them about the local flora/fauna, how and where to find edible fruits and potable water, first aid, how to find their way in the forest and much more. The duration of this hike will be one to three hours, depending on health conditions of the participants. Then guests will have lunch, before going on a fishing tour. Depart lodge in paddle or motorized canoes, accompanied by a Bilingual guide. (Fishing of piranhas and other species, depending on season). It is a non-professional fishing. Upon returning to the lodge, guests will be served dinner.

DAY 06: AMAZON JUNGLE | INC: B/L/D

After breakfast, guests will depart for a tour of Meeting of the Waters. Departs from the lodge at 08h30am on board of a regional double deck boat. The boat goes down the Negro River navigating along the shore of the City of Manaus, allowing passengers to view the Amazonas Theater, the Port of Manaus, the Customs and the interesting aspects of the local life - the stilt houses for instance. Arrival at The Meeting of the Waters by 11h30am (Lunch is not included, during this activity). It's a spectacular merge of Negro and Solimões Rivers. From this point on both rivers form the famous Amazon River that runs all the way to the Atlantic Ocean. The waters of the two rivers run together for about 12kms, side by side, without mixing. The phenomenon happens due to differences in temperature, density and speed of the waters of the rivers. Depending on the level of the waters, a visit to a typical " caboclo " (local inhabitants) villa will be included (at Terra Nova Island) during this full day tour (may not be available during the months of May, June, July and sometimes also August, when the villa is flooded). This visit will happen prior or after lunch. Dinner will be served at the lodge. Duration: about 09 hours

IMPORTANT: The distribution of the tours will be coordinated by the local operation department.

DAY 07: AMAZON JUNGLE / MANAOS / IGUAZU FALLS | INC: B

After breakfast, guests will have a morning of leisure to relax and explore the area, then transfer back to Manaus' Airport for your flight to Iguazu Falls. (FLIGHT MUST TO BE AFTER 14 hs)
Reception at the Airport. Transfer to your Hotel.

DAY 08: IGUAZU FALLS (Argentine side Falls)| INC: B

After breakfast, early in the Morning, get your cameras ready because a memorable experience awaits you as you explore this natural wonder of the world. The 200,000 year old falls span across the border of Argentina, Brazil and Paraguay and are known to pour over 400,000 gallons of water a second onto the rocks below!

We will travel outside the city of Iguassu to the national park where we will spend the day exploring the falls and learning about the history and culture.

The lower path leads to the base of the falls where the intense crash of the falls releases a thick mist into the air.
