Located just 7 minutes from the centre of Queenstown, Swiss-Belresort Coronet Peak is the perfect location to escape and relax as it is surrounded by breathtaking and tranquil scenery.

Queenstown is a year round destination in a spectacular natural scenic environment. In summer (1 December to 28 February), Queenstown enjoys long sunny days with 20-30 degrees Celsius temperatures. Walking, hiking, cycling and mountain biking are popular summer visitor activities. The ski season runs from early June to September (and sometimes into early October), with temperatures dropping from 8 degrees to below zero. Skiing and snowboarding are among favourite winter visitor pastimes.

places of interest

- Coronet Peak Ski Field, is the South Island's most popular ski area, and a short 10 minute drive from Swiss-Belresort Coronet Peak. Diverse terrain, fantastic views, proximity to Queenstown and a cosmopolitan ambience create a superb winter experience for every level of snow sport enthusiast.
- Onsen Hot Pools, located directly across from the hotel, providing indoor/outdoor pools for guests to enjoy some relaxation either during the day overlooking the Shotover Canyons or at night gazing up at the stars.
- Shotover River Jet, provides an adrenaline rush for all ages as the jet boats manoeuvre at high speeds through the canyons on the Shotover River. The boat drivers also enjoy pumping your adrenaline by sending the boats into 360° turns between the canyons.
- Golf Courses including Arrowtown Golf Club, Jacks Point, Kelvin Heights and Millbrook are located within convenient distance to the Swiss-Belresort Coronet Peak. Each provides golf clubs for hire, so there is no need to travel with your own.
- Queenstown Gondola, cable car lift, provides an amazing view of the city's majestic scenery.
- TSS Earnslaw is an iconic 100-year old steamship cruising at Lake Wakatipu which provides not just a stunning view of the Queenstown's scenery but an amazing historical experience.
- Arrowtown: 20 minutes from Queenstown. A historical Gold mining town from the mid 1800's, steeped in history with the Chinese Settlement village, where migrant Mainland Chinese from Guangzhou settled in 1862. Today this historic village remains a major tourist attraction in the area
